Traditionally Troop 50 asks the Scout families to pay dues once a year rather than paying a small amount each week or month*. These dues pay for the Northeast Illinois Council support, troop equipment, Boy's Life magazine, insurance and troop operating expenses. At the same time, we renew our charter with the Boy Scouts of America and update our membership files for the scouts and registered adult members.

The dues for Scouts and registered adult members are **\$55 for each Scout** (\$45 for the second Scout in the same family) and **\$15 per parent or legal guardian per family****. (We recommend that at least one parent be a registered adult member of Troop 50; you may want both parents register so that either parent can drive the boys to events.) In addition, we would also like to update the Annual Health Forms and vehicle registration information at this time. NOTE: Scout account balances can be viewed on www.bsa50.com under Patrols.
